

Emergency Contact& Procedures

(South Dakota, Iowa, & Southern Minnesota)

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- **1. ASSESS** the scene for safety.
- **2. CHECK** the person for responsiveness and life-threatening injuries.
- 3. CALL 9-1-1 for assistance.
- **4. CARE** for the injured person.
- **5. KEEP** uninjured girls together with a responsible adult.
- **6. CONTACT** the following to report emergency:

- 7. SPEAK ONLY TO AUTHORITIES.
- **8. REFER ALL MEDIA** (press, radio, TV) to: Chief Development Officer: Jennifer Hoesing | (605) 906-2871

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

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
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
