Individual Girl Proceeds

For Girls Not in Traditional Troops

Dakota Dough is an incentive Individual Girl Scouts receive for selling items through the Cookie Sale Program. Individual Girl Scouts earn Dakota Dough in place of Troop Proceeds based on the following range calculations for the Cookie Sale Program. The Dakota Dough will be mailed directly to the Individual Girl Scout upon completion of the program. Individual Girl Scouts also receive reward items based on sales levels.

Uses of Dakota Dough

- Pay girl membership dues (cannot apply towards adult memberships)
- Purchase girl program materials
- Purchase retail items from the council stores
- Pay girl registration fees for any service unit, district or council-sponsored program opportunities, destinations, Leadership Institutes or National Council Session
- Individual Girl Scouts have the ability to save their Dakota Dough for future trips or programs. This request must be submitted in writing to Girl Scouts—Dakota Horizons’ (GSDH) CEO. Please include the event name, purpose of the event and date of when the Dakota Dough will be used.

NOTE: The original written permission (from the GSDH CEO) must be presented along with the Dakota Dough when turned into GSDH Council for use. Expired Dakota Dough will not be accepted unless written permission from the CEO or CFO is included when submitted to GSDH for credit.
