



Annual Meeting *April 27, 2019*

As part of the council planning process, the board is interested in gathering input from Delegates on specific topics at this year's Annual Meeting. The topics which will be discussed at the Annual Meeting are:

- What are your ideas to advance the recruiting of girls and volunteers in your area?
- Gold Award Girl Scouts change the world. How can we encourage and support more Girl Scouts to become recipients of this award?

1. Topics are posted on the website at the same time and in the same location as the Annual Meeting materials in late March (at least 30 days prior to the Annual Meeting).

2. Process:

- a. As the elected representatives for their Service Unit, only Delegates will speak to the discussion topics during the Annual Meeting.
- b. When the Board President calls for responses to the discussion items, each location will have the opportunity to allow two Delegates to speak for 1 ½ minutes each. Delegates must state what topic they are addressing. (6 locations = 21 minutes; additional time included for rotating locations.)
- c. Feedback on topics should be given to elected Delegates *prior* to the Annual Meeting.

Immediately following the Annual Meeting there will be a 45 minute social where attendees will have the opportunity to engage in dialogue, provide feedback and share ideas with staff, board members, and other attendees.
