## Day 1:

- Arrive in Savannah.
- Dinner at Tondee's Tavern, replica of a historic meeting place for the Sons of Liberty in the late 1700's.
- 1-hour historic carriage tour of the city.

## Day 2:

- Juliette Gordon Low Birthplace tour.
- Box lunch from Goose Feathers Café, and picnic in city square.
- Tour of the First Girl Scout Headquarters, located in the carriage house behind the Andrew Low House.
- Tour the Andrew Low House.
- Dinner at Fiddlers Crab House.
- 1- hour "Scouting for Spirits" walking ghost tour.

## Day 3:

- Tour Tybee Lighthouse will include the tower, historic buildings and a self-guided tour of Fort Screven.
- Visit Lazaretto Creek Marina for Captain Mike's Dolphin Tour. This will be an hour long boat cruise on the inland waterways, where you will be in search of pods of Atlantic bottle-nose dolphin that come into the protected waters to feed.
- Lunch at Lighthouse Pizza, located near the Tybee Pier.
- Meet the staff at the Marine Science Center for the 2-hour, Coastal Georgia badge program with a variety of beach/ ecology activities in the museum and the tidepools along the shore.
- Dinner at the Pirates House, was once an authentic pirates tavern, and dates to the earliest days of the Georgia colony.
