Cookie Booth Information:



- Girl Scouts will be courteous to all customers and respectful of your location's space.
- Girl Scouts will be accompanied by at least two adults.
- Cookie Booths are generally listed in two hour increments.
- Booth dates and times selected by troops will be listed on the Cookie Finder, available thru our website or download the mobile app. *Note: cancelations (due to weather, etc.) should reflect in the Cookie Finder and not all the times and dates available may be selected by troops.*
- Troops will encourage touchless payment methods to minimize cash handling.
- Troops will clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces and are expected to wash/sanitize hands often.
- Girls are required to limit close contact with others and maintain proper distancing from customers.
- Girl Scouts recommends all participants to wear face coverings during booths.
- Troops are responsible for bringing their own table, signage, and supplies.
- Troops will leave the location as they found it, removing all trash & recycling.
- The girls are covered by Girl Scout insurance while participating in the booth program experience.

To ensure the health and safety of not only our Girl Scouts, but also your customers and staff, we have added COVID-19 protocols to the Booth Guidelines that our troops receive. We will continue to monitor and evaluate the current health environment and may adjust these protocols throughout the program.
