

Emergency Contact & Procedures (South Dakota, Iowa, & Southern Minnesota)

Volunteers and other adults on the scene should:

1. **ASSESS** the scene for safety.
2. **CHECK** the person for responsiveness and life-threatening injuries.
3. **CALL 9-1-1** for assistance.
4. **CARE** for the injured person.
5. **KEEP** uninjured girls together with a responsible adult.
6. **CONTACT** the following to report emergency:

7. **SPEAK ONLY TO AUTHORITIES.**
